We love our Mangy Mutts!

On October 9 we received a phone call. Another batch of puppies was found abandoned. This group was found by a hunter in a field in Bullhead, SD. Someone from Bismarck was headed this way and brought them to CDHS. The rescuers said there were five puppies and what looked like a sixth that had died - in a wire kennel with the door open. They were wearing harnesses. That was confusing.

They had mange and were starving to death. We started out giving them frequent, small meals and all the love and tenderness we could dole out. We cooked up bone broth and hamburger and rice, got them dewormed, and made them as comfortable as possible.

A vet visit revealed sarcoptic mange, which is the very itchy, very contagious kind of mange. The puppies were strictly quarantined for a month and treated with meds and medicated baths for a few months.

The sadness and anger of their condition flowed over us for a minute. But there was no time to dwell on the bad when we believe in the good. In our care they were safe, they were fed, and they were loved.

Thank you to all those who donated on our original Facebook post to help with the expenses for their care. These puppies are now healthy and happy and fully of energetic puppyhood. As of the writing of this article, our country singer crew - Dolly, George, Hank, Merle, and Wynona – are available for adoption.

And yes, we love our MANGY MUTTS. There is no stigma in that phrase for us. These are the best dogs! 🐾

Just wanted to say thanks again for allowing us to adopt Bayou! He has settled in nicely and has found his spot in the family! He is definitely a good fit!

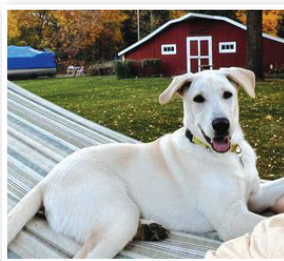

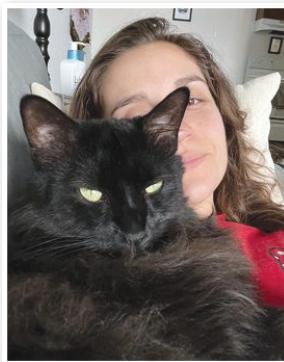

Loki (formerly Shazam) is such a sweetie with a huge personality! He definitely has an attitude, but it fits!

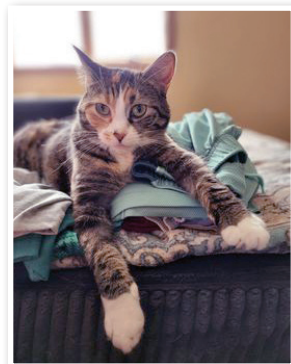

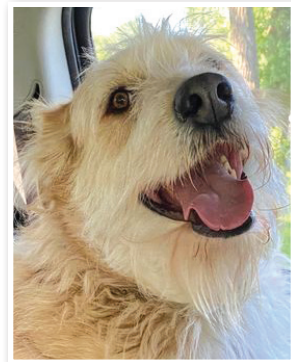

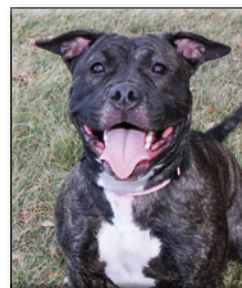
