50 Haircuts in 50 States in 50 Days to Benefit Central Dakota Humane Society

World-record holder and hair stylist Patrick Lomantini will be cutting hair in Bismarck this Saturday, Sept. 3, as part of his 50 States Tour - an effort to perform 50 haircuts in 50 states in 50 days. The event will take place at City Looks in the Kirkwood Mall and will feature Lomantini cutting men's and women's hair from 8 a.m. until 8 p.m.

During his 50 States Tour, Lomantini is bringing awareness to humane societies and shelters and the animals in them. He is donating all proceeds in every state to a local humane society or shelter and so far has raised more than \$23,000 in 28 days. One hundred percent of the proceeds from the Bismarck event will go to the Central Dakota Humane Society. CDHS is taking appointments for the event via phone or email. Lomantini is from Kansas and currently holds the Guinness World Record for cutting hair non-stop for 72 hours.
