This event is a great chance to get professional-quality photos of your pet, child, grandchild or the whole family and support a worthy cause at the same time. All proceeds from the event go to support the animals rescued by CDHS.

No appointments are necessary. People can enjoy refreshments and browse through the beautiful holiday displays at Plant Perfect while they wait.

There is a \$20 fee per pet or person, with \$5 charged for each additional pet or person in the sitting (up to a maximum of \$40). This price includes one 4 x 6 print and all pictures copied to a CD for easy reproduction.

Pictures will be ready for pickup at the CDHS shelter on Saturday, November 19, from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. The shelter is located three miles north of Mandan on Highway 1806 at 2104 37<sup>th</sup> Street.

CDHS is a no-kill animal shelter that serves Bismarck-Mandan and the surrounding communities by housing and finding homes for lost, strayed or abandoned animals, promoting spaying and neutering and offering educational opportunities.
