

It's been a long and winding road for our friend Kalani, but we finally have conquered her skin issues and have this beauty feeling pretty darn good! The before and after photos only tell part of the story but it's plain to see that she is feeling SO much better than when we first met.

The first inclinations from the veterinarians when she first arrived off the streets of Bismarck was allergies and/or parasites. Thus began hit and miss treatments, constant medication adjustments, different tests and food trials with limited success. There was improvement, but she was still itchy and uncomfortable and we wanted to do more to help her if we could. Cat lovers Lee and Jolene Podoll generously offered to sponsor a trip to the University of Minnesota to see a veterinary dermatologist, and we quickly made that appointment and packed her bags - well our bags. Kalani travels light. Anyway, off we went and Kalani was a good traveler. With some advanced diagnostic tools not available locally it was determined that she did not have allergies as we suspected but most likely an autoimmune condition that causes her body to attack itself. The "no allergies" news was a great relief and we began some new medications. Kalani has since enjoyed steady improvement. We now have her looking like a normal kitty and she feels so much better. We think it's time she finds her forever home.



We still consult with Dr. Young at the University of Minnesota via email and photos to update on her condition and make any medication changes. We are

slowly weaning her down to as few meds as possible to maintain her new and improved full body of fur and non-itchy new self. What a relief it must be for her overall comfort, and once again it was our pleasure to be the springboard for Kalani to live a normal, happy life. Through it all she was calm and of good cheer – even when she had a right not to be. Kalani deserves a home that will

pamper her forever and while she may have a little "baggage," she promises to pay you back in extra purrs and snuggles. Special needs cats and dogs are just that, special in their own unique way. It does not make them less deserving of a loving home. If you are interested in adopting Kalani we would be happy to discuss her needs with you. It's not scary, we promise! •

What a wonderful year this has been for CDHS! One big blessing that enters my mind every single day when I come to work is how much I love and appreciate our new cat and administrative facility. When it is cold outside, the first thing that greets us is a nice warm building free of drafts, and rodents, and mold, peeling paint and crumbling concrete and...well, vou get the picture. Animal rescuers can care for animals in some pretty meager surroundings - we know that for a fact. We've seen those days - with roof leaks, patches on top of patches, frozen water bowls in the winter, plumbing that didn't always work, and questionable electrical wires.

It took many years (24 to be exact) to make our upgrade a reality, but we are so thankful to finally have our staff and cats in our new building. The building is bright, clean and airy, with lots of windows and natural light. It's much easier to clean and maintain and we now have a 100 percent healthier environment for the critters, staff, volunteers, and visitors. We hear compliments about our facility nearly every day from first time visitors, as well as long term supporters. We feel like we are living the dream and are so grateful to our supporters for believing in our vision and the work we do to save and shelter animals.

There are many people taking up the cause for animal welfare and protection across our state. Good, kind hearted people who sacrifice family time, blood, sweat, sleep, gasoline, tire treads and

This past year CDHS has rescued strays, taken animals from individuals needing to surrender them, and worked with several cities and counties to take in homeless pets. We have deepened friendships and continue to work with some big hearted, dedicated organizations who deserve some recognition. We have worked with, accepted animals from, and assisted communities and rescues across the state, specifically Standing Rock Reservation, Ft. Totten Reservation, New Town impound, the Bismarck-Mandan impound, Furry Friends Rockin' Rescue, Kitty City, Miles of Love, the Mandan Police Department, Prairie Paws Rescue in Jamestown, the Jamestown city impound, Raise the Woof in Dickinson, and The Little Cottage-ND in Devils Lake.

CDHS is proud to offer our support in kennel space or supplies when others have a need and we are able to do so. We thank our supporters as they helped us send animal supplies, medical supplies, and pet food to shelters in California affected by last fall's devastating wildfires. We also were able to help a shelter in North Carolina after its storage facility was burglarized and they lost all their pet food. CDHS scraped together a pallet full of dog and cat food and sent it on its way.

We are all in this together, and together we are making a difference for every voiceless heartbeat we encounter that needs our care and attention. I heard someone say that we are not just sheltering animals, we are building families. That feels pretty darn good. **4**

I volunteer for you guys because I feel like I can make a difference and am always welcome. I wouldn't volunteer if the staff weren't so awesome and didn't care about what they do. I have sweated, laughed, and cried with these people and animals and never been judged. I've come home with "love" all over my clothes (i.e., slobber and fur).

Bert has a special place in his heart for special needs cats and enjoys hanging out with the felines at the shelter. One day, he was in such a hurry to get to his "volunteer job" that he got a speeding ticket on the way out to the shelter! Bert hangs out and loves up all the "cool cats." Bert says his favorite thing about volunteering at CDHS is, "You get to see a better side of people and gives you an opportunity to spend your time doing something worthwhile and hopefully make a difference in many lives."

Bert's favorite shelter animal is one of our special needs cats, Weebles, or Ms. Weebles, as Bert refers to her. He says she is just too easy to love. Bert always makes time for Weebles even if he only has a few minutes to spare. Weebles has a condition known as cerebellar hypoplasia, which is a developmental condition in which the cerebellum of the brain fails to develop properly. The cerebellum controls fine motor skills, balance and coordination. Weebles, who is 16, has lived most of her life at the shelter and has gone from tottering around to being basically immobile. In the summer, Bert takes Weebles outside so she can enjoy the fresh air and sunshine.

Bert doesn't ignore the other felines though. He helps to socialize them and lets them stretch their legs in the visiting rooms. Bert has his own rescues but stills makes time several days a week to visit the cats at CDHS. When asked how he felt about the shelter Bert said, "The staff work tirelessly, taking on the endless task of helping animals in need

# **Good-Bye CDHS Board – Hello, CDHS**




