Caring For Critters While Coping With COVID-19

More people can identify with shelter animals now than at any other time in recent history. Social distancing and selfisolation have turned our homes into places of confinement, where we long to see familiar faces and get back to our normal routines.

"It seems like you can't go out to do anything—it feels like I haven't seen my friends in forever," said CDHS staff member Kaysi. "I went to Walmart and now they have the rule where they only let so many people in, and it took forever."

CDHS staff is coping with the "new normal" of COVID-19 much like others in our area. Those who would normally spend time out and about in the community are staying home and limiting what they do in public.

"I don't run errands as often as before, and am probably more organized when I do," said Marcia.

"I used to enjoy shopping," Melissa said with a wry laugh. In addition to changes in her own routine, Melissa is also dealing with virtual schooling for her teenage son, and trying to find ways to fill his time that would normally be spent with peers.

"He can't play the little kid activities that people keep suggesting on Facebook, and he can't just hang out with friends either," Melissa said. "It's hard to find something in between."

And there have been changes at CDHS as well, with no public access and reduced staff hours.

"I think [the reduced schedule] does bother us all, but that's just how it's going to have to be for a while," Kendra said. "It's made it a lot slower, more time to work with the dogs themselves and to clean and keep everything up to par. We try to care for the animals as best we can."

Staff have been taking extra precautions, deep-cleaning in both the cat and dog buildings, paying extra attention to common areas and surfaces that are frequently touched, and doing a lot of handwashing. Signs of illness are not being taken lightly.

"If you get sick and are feeling better, [normally] you might come back the next day," said a staff member, who recently had a stomach bug. "With [COVID-19], it was 72 hours before I could come back."

As with others in the community, the staff member was advised by a doctor to stay home unless her symptoms worsened, and to not return to work for at least 72 hours. Since she didn't have severe symptoms and doesn't work in the medical industry, she was not a candidate for COVID-19 testing.

"I might not have even stayed home normally—my stomach was a little upset and I would've pushed through it, but with this you just don't take any chances," the staff member said. "You have to think, you're not only risking yourself but everyone you live with."

One of the hardest things for staff to deal with is how closing the doors to the public is affecting our four-legged residents. Staff has been spending extra time, often after finishing their shifts, to make sure residents are getting at least some of the "people time" they're used to.

"The kitties are just missing that extra attention," said Brenda. "Even when we try to sit with them after work, there are always those you can't get to or need more attention, that's what I feel sorry for."

"I've been taking extra time with the cats – they obviously miss the volunteers," Melissa said. "You always hear jokes about how cats want to be left alone. Cats need more attention than people think. They really want people around and they really want the attention."

While felines may be more subtle, the canines are pretty straight-forward. "The dogs are definitely getting a little stir crazy," Kaysi said. "There are a few dog walkers allowed in, but the dogs don't get the exercise they normally do. There's just not enough time to take them all for the kinds of walks they need, but we are doing the best we can."

All in all, CDHS staff and residents are looking forward to the shelter doors

Making The Best of a COVID-19 Disruption

It never has been "same stuff, different day" around

here, but since mid-March, I must admit it has felt a lot like Groundhog Day. Our business has temporarily closed to the public and we are dealing with it the best way we know how. The majority of CDHS employees has been coming to work as usual to physically care for our residents, a few worked from home when they could, and we did have to cut back a bit on employee hours. We did follow through with adoptions that had been approved at the beginning of this whole COVID catastrophe – with some extra social distancing precautions in place.

We are a small group and the fear of a few of us ending up with a 14-day quarantine period made us all extra aware of the space surrounding us and the risks we wanted to take in the outside world. Same for everyone else, I know, but what a strange disruption to our routine and our day to day, right? I was not on board with changing my routine and changing the way we do EVERYTHING else as well, but then again nobody asked me. So here we are.

As of the writing of this report, we are still not sure when the shelter can be open to the public and still not sure how many animals we can safely accept into the shelter. National humane organizations have been offering up advice and protocols to deal with all animal-related situations. We are learning all we can about the safety protocols necessary if we should be asked to assist with a pet coming from a Covid-19 home. We are prepared for that possibility. Today is a new world and we are living and working in it.

Despite the disruptions, we have made good use of our time. We care for the fuzz kids every day just as before – food, medications, clean bedding, and some rubs and scritches (therapeutic for both critter and caretaker). Staff has more time

to walk the dogs, teach a new trick or two or just sit for a few minutes and enjoy the company of a purring cat. You may think that is our normal day, but really, it's not. The phone has been quiet for the most part and kind donors have left much needed supplies outside our doors. We have set up a new animal tracking software program and have been learning that and logging animal info into the system. We have taken advantage of online webinars, have cleaned and organized and cleaned again.

Enter the Groundhog. This new normal is still not as normal as we need to get

to. Just like so many other businesses, we need to get everyone working again, we need to get back to business, but obviously, we do need to be safe and smart, and protect those most vulnerable. We can do this, and we will do this. It's dark and scary out there, but you all have shown us the light at the end of the tunnel. Take care of yourself and each other. We look forward to being of full service to you again very, very soon.

(Editor's note: Hopefully, by the time you read this, things in our world will be on the way back to business as usual.)

CDHS FANTASTIC FOSTERS - In 2019, 10 foster families dedicated more than 2,300 hours caring for 48 kittens – almost half of the 105 kittens taken in by CDHS. Several families took on the daunting task of caring for more than one litter over the course of "kitten season"; others dedicated themselves to litters that were medically or socially challenged.

Foster families bottle-fed the tiniest orphans up to six times per day, stimulated them to potty (a task usually left to their mothers), and treated everything from upper respiratory infections to eye infections to pneumonia. As "their kids" grew, fosters introduced the babies to solid foods and using the litter box, drove them to vet appointments and to CDHS for vaccinations, and kept up with what seems like constant clean-up during the first six weeks of life. They enjoyed play and snuggle times and seeing the kittens grow and thrive, and survived the mixed blessing of bringing the babies back to CDHS, ready for adoption into their forever homes.

CDHS Events Update

She has blessed the CDHS shelter cat/administration building with her talent of drawing and painting colorful, cute, and creative works of art. One positive thing about the COVID-19 lockdown we are living in is that Carrie had a bit of extra time and was able to create some new art that will greet our shelter visitors when we are able to open back up to the public.

Her latest art is in one of our free roam cat rooms and is called "2020 – A Space Oddity." The subject matter includes cat and mouse astronauts, the moon, and some very desirable chunks

of cheese. Carrie previously painted a surfing cat that appears in the FIV cat room and several paintings in the "European wing" cat room.

Making Shelter Life More Comfortable

CDHS staff member, Tami, has a talent for sewing and creating. She used her time and talents – and some scraps from torn blankets, donated items, and pillowcases – to create a beautiful new blanket for shelter resident, Jemma. She even included a soft pillow made from an old t-shirt.

Tami said, "Jemma LOVES to get new things – like collars, toys, blankets – and she is one of the dogs that does not shred her blankets. I realized there were some torn blankets and some pillowcases that we couldn't use, so I thought I could make Jemma a new blanket from the scraps."

Tami does other creative and frugal projects at the shelter, including sponsoring and assembling the adopted dogs' bandanas and "bug out" bags (filled with a blanket, toys, and treats) that they get when they are adopted. She also performs surgery on donated stuffed toys, removing the beans and the hard eyeballs and then stitching them back up so that the dogs can safely play with them. The beans can even be used in a litter box – for cats that we need to get a urine sample from. The cats think it is regular litter, but we are able to collect that urine sample that runs to the bottom, something we couldn't do with regular clay litter. What a great, money-saving idea!

As you can see in the pictures, Jemma was one happy girl and loves her special new blanket. Thank you, Tami, for taking the time to provide comfort and love for our shelter pets!
