CDHS Sets New Adoption Policies/Fees with Goal to Help More Animals

With a goal set to move pets into great homes quicker and make adoption procedures more convenient for adopters, CDHS has made some adjustments to the adoption process and the fee structure at the shelter. Starting January 1, all pets will be spayed or neutered prior to adoption. That way, once they are available, they can more quickly be adopted into homes. All pets also will begin receiving microchips prior to leaving the shelter.

Along with the changes to the adoption process, a new adoption fee structure will be put into place, with prices changing to:

Puppies (under 1 year) - \$300 plus tax

Dogs - \$250 plus tax

Kittens (under 1 year) - \$150 plus tax

Cats - \$80 plus tax

"On the face of it, people may look at our adoption fees and think that the price of adopting a pet has gone up, but that is not the case," said Sue Buchholz, shelter director. "In the past, the adopter was responsible for the expense of the spay or neuter, and that was added to the adoption fee. Now, the shelter will be absorbing those initial expenses, so in the end, the cost is actually lower than it used to be. Adding the microchip also adds to the cost absorbed by the shelter, but it helps to ensure the lifelong safety of the adopted pet and we feel that is important."

Adoption fees for dogs and puppies includes spay or neuter surgery, microchip, veterinary exam, distemper vaccine, rabies vaccine, ear mite treatment and flea/tick treatment (if needed), deworming, nail trim, adoption advising, free bag of food, adoption goodie bag, and local business discounts.

Adoption fees for cats and kittens includes spay or neuter surgery, microchip, veterinary exam, distemper vaccine, rabies vaccine, ear mite treatment and flea/tick treatment (if needed), deworming, nail trim, adoption advising, free bag of food, and adoption goodie bag.

"CDHS adoption fees have always been and still are an incredible bargain to adopt a new best friend," said Buchholz. "We realize that the shelter never will recoup all the expenses incurred when rescuing and caring for the pets. Just like most

animal rescues, we need to fund some expenses through our adoption fees, but we know those fees won't pay the whole cost. Animal rescue is not a money-making endeavor. CDHS works hard to raise the money needed to care for the pets and match them with their best home. Our community, donors, and supporters keep the wheels turning – they are instrumental in helping these animals find love with their forever families."

In the past, if the spay or neuter surgery involved extra costs due to underlying health conditions of the pet, those costs were paid by the adopter. Now, those costs will be absorbed by CDHS. CDHS continues to fund the pet's medical expenses, food, housing, and the care provided by the CDHS staff prior to adoption. Staff and volunteers will continue to work hard to raise the money needed to make up the difference in expenses – through fundraiser events, donation drives, memberships, raffles, auctions, merchandise sales, and grant writing.

"Ultimately, what we wish is for all pets to be in loving homes and not fending for themselves as strays," said Buchholz. "It's our goal to help more animals and these new adoption policies will be a step toward making that happen."

Shelter Report

I strongly suspect that I am not alone in looking forward to putting 2020 in the rearview mirror. I hold on to hope that 2021 will eventually

be better and safer for all of us. The allure of "normal" is more appealing than ever before.

Over the years we have budgeted a relatively small amount annually for something we call our PET Fund, which stands for Providing Emergency TLC. This fund was originally funded for \$1200, which we earmarked for emergency medical needs of owned animals or emergency situations in the community (fires, floods, etc.) – ways we could provide aid to someone with pets in need.

Sometimes we are contacted by our veterinary partners about a client that requires surgery and their human has extremely limited funds. Sometimes it's the pet owners themselves that contact us seeking assistance for food, or medications or just looking for advice. It really isn't something that we have advertised. It started as an internal tool that was generated by requests received, and by emergencies that happened in the community.

It is not our intention or ability to fully fund surgeries for owned pets, but we hope to be able to offer a small helping hand in times of emergency. We try to make the best use of the money as we can. Many years our funds have been depleted before February had passed. In the case of large emergencies later in the year (like the apartment fires), we sometimes are able to pull unused funds from other budget items.

I wanted to make our supporters aware of this giving opportunity and let you know about some of the ways we have been privileged to lend a hand...to a paw.

- We have contributed financially to several life-saving surgeries.
- We purchased pet food and supplies that we delivered to Mandan fire victims, even as the firefighters were still working to put out the flames.

- We purchased and delivered food and mediations to a few pet owners who were housebound due to Covid-19.
- In one situation where an elderly companion of a diabetic cat could afford insulin but came up short for syringes, we were able to supply a month's worth of syringes to help keep kitty regulated.
- We regularly supply Community Action and Heaven's
 Helpers Soup Café with cat and dog food so they can
 share with their clients who have pets in need. Sadly,
 we hear that within a few days of taking a pickup load
 of pet food to Community Action their shelves are once
 again bare.
- Several times in 2020 we housed pets while their owners have been hospitalized, or otherwise were without a home to call their own. These cases are heartbreaking because the animals are sadly missing their people and the people are sorely missing their animals. We work together to resolve these situations and get families reunited under the same roof. Those reunions make for some pretty heartwarming feel good days, let me tell you!

As we discuss next year's uncertain budget we are estimating that requests for funds that fall under the PET Fund will come in as never before. If this service touches your heart, consider designating your donations (or a portion thereof) to the PET Fund. We realize every day that we are donor driven, no matter what services we provide. There is a constant outflow of funds for our shelter residents in the form of food, medications, vaccinations, veterinary care, heat, electricity, staff to provide daily care, fuel for lifesaving transports, the list goes on and on.

Now more than ever we have people hurting in our community and CDHS supporters supply the means to help people and their pets, which ultimately helps us all. When you partner with us and support the animals, you help in ways you may have never imagined. We are honored that you invest in CDHS! We are stronger together and intend to be here to help pets and people for many years to come. •

Why Become a CDHS Volunteer Now?

1. Volunteering makes you feel better about everything. Let's be honest, we are struggling through

some tough times right now. Many things we have taken for granted have changed and we are wondering when our new "normal" will return. The needs of the dogs and cats at CDHS have not changed. They are still in need of your touch and kindness and they need us to show them why they should give us "hoomans" another chance.

- 2. CDHS needs volunteers. We have animals coming into our shelter every day. Each one needs to be cared for physically and emotionally. Our staff does the best they can with the hours in their workday. Many stay late or come early to get in as much "critter time" as they can, but they are also busy answering the phones, cleaning kennels, giving medications, taking requests from supporters, planning fundraisers, etc. We need volunteers every hour of every day we are open to the public. When you are spending time in the kennel with a dog, you will see them relax and fall asleep because they know you are there. That cat in your lap will start to purr and you will know their renewed trust came about because of the hours you spent with them. Your time spent with an animal is the most important time to that animal!
- 3. Being an animal shelter volunteer is good for your emotional, physical, and mental health. It is scientifically proven that spending time with animals helps lower your hormone stress levels and blood pressure. It can also help you deal with depression and anxiety. It increases your levels of serotonin and dopamine, which helps you feel calm and relaxed. Hearing a cat purr does something to your heart. Remember the story of the Grinch that stole Christmas? Your heart will grow 10 sizes by volunteering. Dogs and cats are great listeners and will never argue with you. You will always get in the last word!
- 4. Volunteering is a great way to show a future employer that you are a good person. Job experience is important, but being a good citizen to all of the world's creatures shows you have a kind heart. It also gives you another resource for references. Showing up on time, following directions, and being able to fulfill commitments shows that you are a valuable part of the community. Who wouldn't want to hire someone like that?
- 5. Volunteering fulfills a civic responsibility. You get to contribute to a cause you care about. It makes a difference and makes you feel involved in your community. It gives you a chance to give back. That's a big deal!
- 6. When you volunteer, you will meet people who are just like you and will make connections and human friends too. We all need community and now more than ever. Most of us are spending more time alone than ever before. You can visit from a

So, why become a CDHS volunteer? Because it is good for you and your health. It is good for the shelter animals and their health. You will instantly see the results of your work. You will see the animals you work with relax and their personality will come out. Now that is certainly the most rewarding work you will ever do and now is the right time to do it!

CDHS is working to make our shelter safe for volunteers and visitors. We are currently scheduling all adoption visitors and cat volunteers (at times they prefer) to make sure there is a limited number of people in our buildings at one time. Dog walking volunteers are socially distanced from other folks. We sanitize frequently, masks are required inside the shelter, we have multiple hand sanitizing stations available, and we have installed new HALO air purification systems (that we were able to purchase with a grant). If you prefer to volunteer to help CDHS from your home, please don't hesitate to call. We often have clerical or creative work that can be done remotely. And it still helps the animals!

Our Volunteers are Pawsome!

Danny Selinger is this quarter's Pawsome Volunteer! He has been volunteering for CDHS for about three years.

Danny spends most of his time helping to socialize our cats, but he is always willing to assist with various shelter projects. He helps with whatever he can, even if it includes a shovel and a wheel barrel! He has helped with gardening and landscaping projects, as well as moving items here and there and unloading supplies or whatever the staff asks. He has become a "regular" in the cat building and is loved by many, both feline and human!







Adopt a Team with 2-for-1 Adoption Fees

The first cat my husband and I got as newlyweds was a solo pet. Scooter was a wonderful tuxedo girl and we loved her like crazy, but I forever regretted not adopting her brother at the same time we took her home. She always seemed pretty lonely and was crabby and aggressive to everyone but us. We could definitely tell that as much we played with her and snuggled her, she was bored. She would bang the cupboard doors and slap the window blinds – in the middle of the night, of course.

Our experience with our first cat made us determined to always have more than one cat at a time. Our next adoption was two sisters, and our latest adoption was three sisters. Best decisions ever!

If you are considering adopting a kitten or cat, please check out CDHS's offer of 2-for-1 adoption fees on kittens and cats. Two kitties for the adoption fee of one is great for your pocketbook and great for the kitties.

CDHS offers this fee opportunity for two main reasons. One, cats, and especially kittens, often do better physically, socially and emotionally

if they have an animal companion in their life. They enjoy having someone to romp, play, sleep, and snuggle with. Kitties with a pal usually are more active, which can mean better health. When kitty wants to roughhouse, they can pounce on their sibling rather than your arm. That's a win for you too! Second, our goal is to find new homes for as many animals as we can. Sending two kitties home together opens spots in the shelter to rescue TWO more cats in need. That could be the difference between freezing and starvation for a stray cat, or food and warmth at CDHS – and soon, a new family.

Some adopters have commented that they just want one cat because they want the kitty to play and sleep with them. This is a completely valid desire, but when you are gone to work, or when you leave for a trip, you will feel much better knowing that your beloved kitties have someone else to comfort them. Even though your cats will spend time with each other, they will also spend time with you in their own way. Each of our cats snuggles and purrs or plays with us separately when we are home. Of my three kitties, one likes to sleep snuggled next to me, one sleeps by my feet, and one sleeps under the bed (I think she feels safer there). But, when we are gone, snuggle kitty will always sleep with one of her sisters and sometimes all three sleep together. I'm glad they have each other.

Yes, you will have to scoop litter for an extra kitty, but you are scooping litter anyway, so... well, you know. And yes, I will concede that having two cats does add a bit to the vet bills, but nothing beats watching the kitties chase each around the house and crash out on the couch, curled up together for a long snooze.

Of course, not all cats love the buddy system. Some do prefer to be loners. But, more often than not, cats who go home together find a way to get along with their housemates, especially when they are adopted together as kittens.

So, in the interest of helping the kitties and to add to the rewarding feeling you get from adopting, I encourage you to take two for the team – and adopt a pair. \checkmark
